

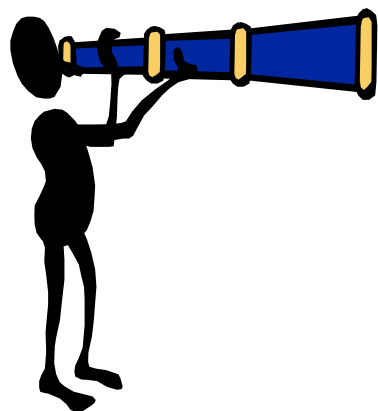

(FIC Crutcher, C.)

*Whale Talk* by Chris Crutcher.

(FIC Werlin, N.) *Black Mirror* by Nancy Werlin. Convinced her brother's death was murder rather than suicide, sixteen-yr-old Frances begins at her own investigation into suspicious student at her boarding

school.
