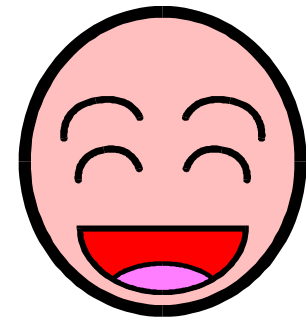

(811 \$il) Where the Sidewalk Ends by Shel Silverstein

A boy who turns into a TV set and a girl who eats a whale are only two of the characters in a collection of humorous poetry illustrated with the author's own drawings.

(811.08 O36) Oh, Such Foolishness!: Poems by Various Authors

A collection of humorous and nonsense poems.

(827.8 L43) The Complete Nonsense Book by Edward Lear

Lear's introduction to more nonsense songs and stories.

(FIC Adams, D) The Hitchhiker's Guide to the Galaxy by Douglas Adams

Join Douglas Adams's hapless hero Arthur Dent as he travels the galaxy with his intrepid pal Ford Prefect, getting into horrible messes and generally wreaking hilarious havoc.

(FIC Aiken, J) The Cuckoo Tree by Joan Aiken

As the result of an accident a young girl is faced with the responsibility of foiling a Hanoverian lot to put the St. Paul's Cathedral on rollers and roll it into the River Thames during the coronation of James IV.

(FIC Blume, J) Fudge-A-Mania by Judy Blume

Pete describes the family vacation in Maine with the Tubmans, highlighted by the antics of his younger brother Fudge.

(FIC Cabot) All-American Girl by Meg Cabot

A sophomore girl stops a presidential assassination attempt, is appointed Teen Ambassador to the United Nations, and catches the eye of the very cute First Son.

(FIC Conford, E) If This is Love, I'll Take Spaghetti by Ellen Conford

Nine short stories explore the trials and tribulations of teenage life.

(FIC Eberhardt) Rat Boys: A Dating Experience by Thom Eberhardt

14 year olds Marci and Summer use a magic ring to turn two rats into cute boys so they can have dates for the spring fling.

(FIC Ferris) Once Upon A Marigold by Jean Ferris

A young man with a mysterious past and a penchant for inventing things leaves the troll who raised him, meets an unhappy princess he has loved from afar, and discovers a plot against her and her father.

(FIC Keller, B) Desdemona — Twelve Going On Desperate by Beverly Keller

Calamity stalks a seventh grader in the form of social disasters, and throughout it all, to her great embarrassment, she keeps running into the most attractive boy in school.

(FIC Paulsen) The Schernoff Discoveries by Gary Paulsen

Harold and his best friend, both hopeless geeks and social misfits, try to survive unusual science experiments, the attacks of the football team, and other dangers of junior high school.

(FIC Pinkwater, D) Lizard Music by Daniel Manus Pinkwater

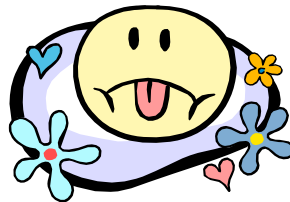
When left to take care of himself, a young boy becomes involved with a community of intelligent lizards who tell him of a little known invasion from outer space.

(FIC Pratchett) Maskerade: A Novel of Discworld by Terry Pratchett

When Discworld's opera house is found to be haunted, a trio of witches is summoned to flush out the unwanted ghost but the results only seem to complicate matters.

(FIC Rennison) Angus, Thongs and Full-Frontal Snogging: Confessions of Georgia Nicolson by Louise Rennison

Presents the humorous journal of a year in the life of a 14 year old British girl who tries to reduce the size of her nose, stop her mad cat from terrorizing the neighborhood animals, and win the love of handsome hunk Robbie.

(FIC Snicket, L) The Bad Beginning by Lemony Snicket

After the sudden death of their parents, the three Baudelaire children must depend on each other and their wits when it turns out that the distant relative who is appointed their guardian is determined to use any means necessary to get their fortune.
