- If we do not have what you are looking for here at the MHS Library, try the Montclair Branch Library or another local public library.



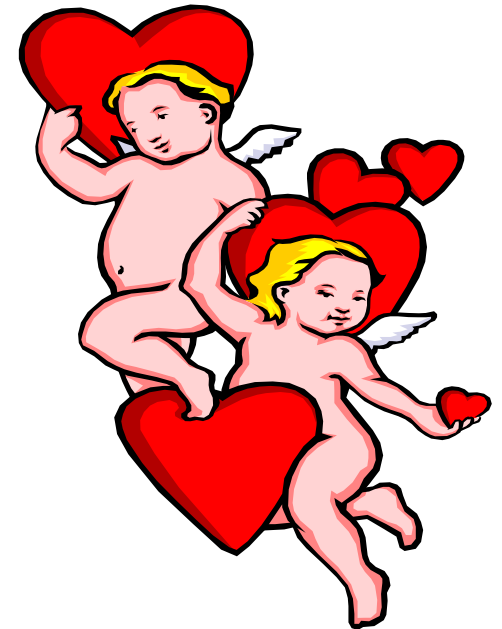
