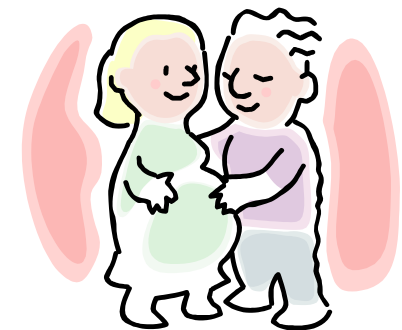

- ◆ *If we don't have what you are looking for here at the MHS Library, try the Montclair Branch Library or another local library.*



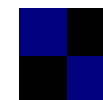

Teenage Pregnancy Books (non-fiction)

(306.46 Tak) Taking Sides: Clashing views on controversial issues in health and society by Eileen L. Daniels

This book answers questions like "Does sex education prevent teen pregnancy?" and "Can abortion be a morally acceptable choice?"

(306.732 AYE) It's Okay to Say No Choosing Sexual Abstinence by Eleanor H. Ayer

This book discusses what abstinence means, the dangers of teenage sexual activity, the difficulty of choosing abstinence, and the advantages of abstaining from sex.

(306.732 KRE) In Control: Learning to Say No to Sexual Pressure by Anna Kreiner

Discusses different kinds of sexual pressure and considers ways young people can negotiate with their partners and determine their own values and ethics regarding sex.

(306.874 Bye) Teens and Pregnancy: A Hot Issue by Ann Byers

Discusses teen pregnancy as a social problem and outgrowth of the sexual culture in the United States, as well as ways to avoid pregnancy and options for the teen that does become pregnant.

(306.874 End) Teen Pregnancy: Tough Choices by Julie K. Endersbe

Describes what teenagers can expect during and after pregnancy, the options to abort, choose adoption, or become a parent, methods of preventing pregnancy, and other dilemmas.

(306.874 Tee) Teen Pregnancy and Parenting by Helen Cothran

Authors discuss whether or not teen pregnancy is a serious problem, the factors that contribute to teen pregnancy, what alternatives exist to teen parenting, and the approaches that society should take to address the issue.

(306.874 TRA) Listen Up!: Teenage Mothers Speak Out by Margi Trapani

Teenage mothers highlight the challenges of being a teen parent, discussing responsibility, economic hardship, and emotional issues involved in parenting at a young age.

(306.8742 MOE) A Question of Timing: Successful Men Talk About having Children by Barbara Moe

Young men discuss how delaying or deciding against fatherhood has allowed them to accomplish career and personal goals.

(306.8742 TRA) Reality Check: Teenage Fathers Speak Out by Margi Trapani

Teenage fathers highlight the challenges of being a teen parent, discussing responsibility, economic hardship, and emotional issues involved in parenting at a young age.

(362.74 Tee) Teens at Risk: Opposing Viewpoints by Lauren K. Egen-dorf

Discusses what factors can put teenagers at risk for suicide, teen pregnancy, gang violence, drugs, and other dangers.

(306.8743 MIL) Teenage Pregnancy and Poverty: the Economic Reality by Barbara Miller

This book discusses the problem of teen pregnancy and how it affects the economic future of the persons involved.

(306.8743 SUN) Why I Waited: Successful Women Talk about their Pregnancy Choices by P.L. Sunderland

Eight women of different backgrounds tell why they delayed childbearing and how this decision had allowed them to achieve personal and career goals.

(613.953 JAM) A Baby Doesn't make the Man: Alternative Sources of Power and Manhood for Young Men by Raymond Jamiolkowski

Discusses reasons why teenage boys engage in sex, the consequences of irresponsible sexual activity, and alternative ways for young men to feel good about themselves.

(618.2 Hug) Everything You Need to Know About Teen Pregnancy by Tracy Hughes

This book discusses such aspects of teen pregnancy as the causes and nature, the proper care for mother and baby, and alternative choices.
